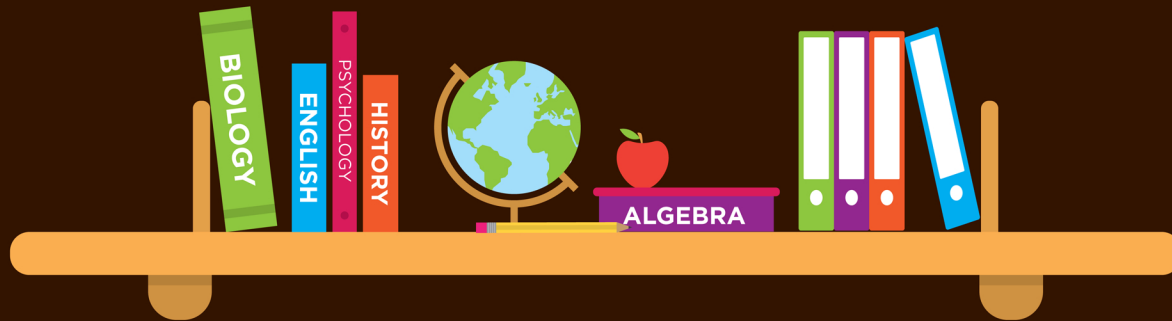


# THE FLORIDA PRE K-12 EDUCATION LANDSCAPE

School choice is now mainstream. Of Florida's 3.5 million PreK-12 students, 42 percent attended a school of their choice during the 2013-14 school year.

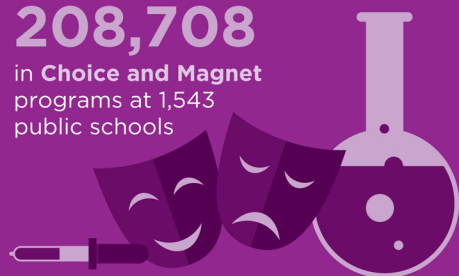

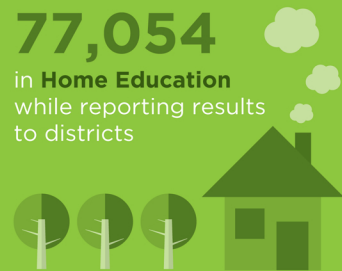
