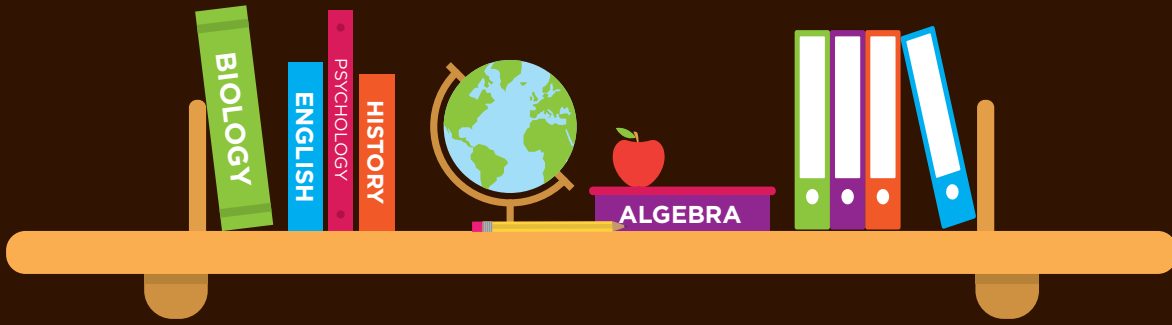


THE FLORIDA PRE K-12 EDUCATION LANDSCAPE



1.5 MILLION STUDENTS CHOOSE

School choice is now mainstream. Of Florida's 3.5 million PreK-12 students, 43 percent attended a school of their choice during the 2014-15 school year.

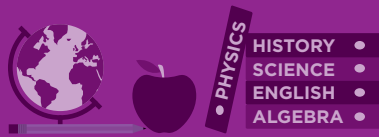
